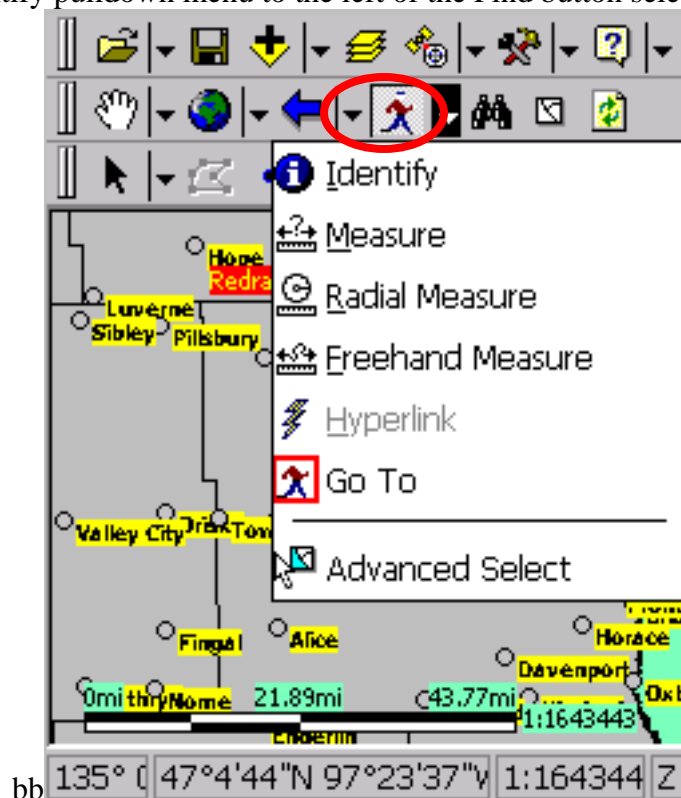


ArcPad Exercise 4: Using the “GoTo” Function in ArcPad

Open an existing or new ArcPad map. Add a background layers to the map such as the county boundaries and towns for the state.

1. From the Identify pulldown menu to the left of the Find button select “Go To”.

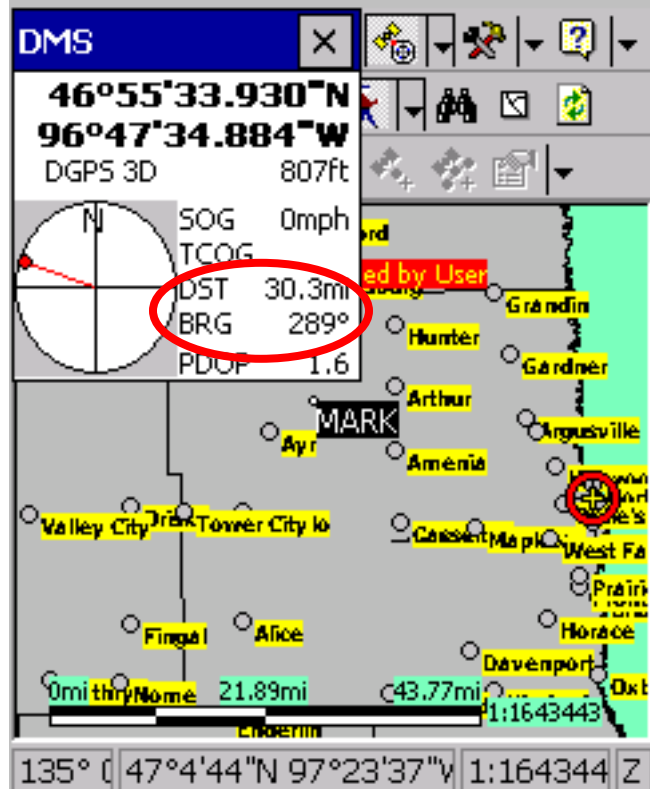

2. With the “Go To” button selected, use the stylus to Mark a point to “go to”



3. Open the GPS Position Window.
 - a. Note the “DST” Distance is 30.3 miles, and “BRG” Bearing 289 degrees.



- b. Tapping the “sky” display will allow toggling between “satellite sky” to “satellite strength bars” to “compass”. The compass displays the direction to “Go To” mark.
