

**River Ranger, Snake River

Summer Season 2008**

**Positions:** 2 positions are available

**Start Date:** End of May

**End Date:** minimum of mid-August, but can possibly stay longer

**Work Schedule:** This is a 5 day/40 hr a week position, with every member of the crew working at least one day of the weekend.

**Pay:** GS-3/4/5 which is dependent on experience and education

**Housing:** Forest Service housing is available south of Jackson near Hoback Junction

**Daily duties include, but are not limited to the following:**

- Make professional visitor contacts to provide and gain information
- Enforce non-commercial and institutional group permit program
- Help maintain all recreation day use sites in the Snake River and Hoback Canyons
- Assist on any projects as needed
- Patrol canyon corridors via vehicle; boat ramps, campgrounds, dispersed sites and enforce any rules as needed
- Patrol on-river in USFS rafts to make visitor contacts, enforce rules, pick up garbage etc.
- Monitor commercial whitewater use to ensure following permitted activities
- Monitor commercial fishermen and track use
- Work closely with the Snake River Fund to implement projects and education programs along the river

This position is mainly an on-land river position with occasional on-river patrols, working the boat ramps, enforcing permit regulations, and working with the public. Ideally someone with great communication and people skills, ability to be flexible with daily job duties (every day is different on the river), and knowledgeable in resource/recreation management is preferred. River navigating/boating skills are very helpful for this position, but are not a requirement. Training is available. Anyone looking for a summer of great experience in this field will not be disappointed.
