

Internship in Hydrology and Water Management, Friends of the Teton River
Summer 2009

Friends of the Teton River (FTR) (www.tetonwater.org) is seeking an intern to conduct hydrologic and water quality monitoring programs. FTR is a research-based non-profit 501(c) (3) organization dedicated to protecting the water resources of the Teton Valley, Idaho/Wyoming.

The intern will be responsible for monitoring and measuring flows in streams and diversions throughout the Teton Valley and conducting surface and ground water quality sampling. The intern will also be responsible for mentoring and supervising a high school aged intern. Mentoring is an important aspect of the position, and candidates must be willing and able to fulfill this role.

Candidates should have a background in water resources or environmental science, ability to work in a team environment, strong organizational skills, experience working in variable outdoor conditions, and a working knowledge of Microsoft Excel and Word. This position involves a great deal of field data collection in a dramatic setting beside the Teton Mountains. For a motivated candidate, significant opportunities exist to customize this experience to further their own educational goals and to interface with an ongoing surface water/groundwater modeling study. Pay is \$10-11/hour DOE. Duration of internship is approximately May 15th to September 1st 2009 with flexibility to accommodate academic schedule.
