What: Biological Aid or Biological Technician positions (2 - 6 positions available), GS-0404-3/4, working under the Student Temporary Experience Program (STEP) from May through the end of August. Main duties involve facilities installation/management, tree removal, water management, wetland and grassland restoration, waterfowl counts, surveying, etc.

Who: U.S. citizens enrolled in, or accepted for enrollment as, a full-time or part-time student in an accredited college or university. To qualify for employment at the GS-3 level, you must have successfully completed one year of study that included at least six semester hours in any combination of scientific or technical courses such as biology, chemistry, statistics, entomology, animal husbandry, botany, physics, agriculture, or mathematics. Or, has a combination of college level education and related work experience. Please submit a transcript.
