- In this position you would provide practical application of wildlife management and control techniques to 3-4 Youth Conservation Corps enrollees studying natural resource conservation;
- Assist enrollees in field work projects designed to illustrate conservation practices;
- Schedule and participate in educational activities for the enrollees;
- Maintain records of the enrollees' accomplishments;
- Assist in maintaining a safe work environment for the enrollees.
